The study of architecture is an exciting multidisciplinary field that synthesizes design investigation with historical and cultural perspectives, social responsibilities, technical excellence, and leadership. Architectural Studies will introduce you to these ideas through a sequence of architectural design prompts. It will provide an opportunity to test the fit of architecture with your future aspirations. Students will investigate design issues through the traditional processes of model making and drawing while also being introduced to the latest software tools used in the architecture industry. Students will develop both visual representation and verbal presentation skills. There may also be off-campus field trips. This course will end with a presentation of student work to guests from the UW Department of Architecture and Seattle design community. There are no prerequisite skills required for this class - just interest and enthusiasm!
